## SUMMER OPENING FOR SAGE LODGE

Sage Lodge, situated on more than a mile of Yellowstone riverfront, is expected to open in Emigrant this summer. The rural resort will feature 50 total guest rooms located in a 34-room lodge and four stand-alone cabins. Among the many highlights are a Montanainspired restaurant and bar complete with a wood-fired grill, and a fitness center with an outdoor workout space. Indoor and outdoor meeting and event spaces for up to 150 people are planned, including the 2,500-squarefoot event barn, three small meeting rooms, 1,800 square feet of prefunction space and a spacious lawn. Following the lodge's grand opening, a full-service spa with several soaking pools is scheduled to open in late 2018. ## HISTORIC RIALTO REOPENS IN BOZEMAN

Originally built in 1908 as a two-story storefront and converted into a theater in 1924, the Rialto has a long history of serving Bozeman. The landmark was recently transformed into a cultural hub featuring live performances, private meeting and event spaces, a beer and wine bar and state-of-the-art acoustics. Although the structure sat vacant for more than a decade, it reopened in January 2018 as a reinvented venue that includes a groundfloor Black Box theater that accommodates up to 400 and has a mezzanine level. The second floor features Burn Box, a stylish space overlooking Main Street that serves wine, beer and a rotating menu created by local chefs and food artisans. Light Box, adjacent to Burn Box, is a gallery that showcases work from local artists and serve as additional private event space for 15-150 guests. rialtobozeman.com
